- Thinking of setting a minimum amount of time that hunt has to last before stopping – Mary requested the comments
 - 45 minutes suggested and agreed with by all
 - Mary will take the comments to the committee
- Proposals being discussed
 - the solo requirement removed from Jr Hunter Excellent, it is easier to get a Sr Hunter than a Jr Hunter Excellent
 - require “climb the ladder” on titles ... Jr Hunter, Jr Hunter Excellent, Sr Hunter, etc. However the AKC only recognizes the regular titles, not the excellent
 - Changing requirements for Jr Hunter to 3 scores instead of 4, like other hunt titles
 - gun shy tests – change wording to say the gun may be fired when the dogs are “actively working” instead of being on an active chase

Annual Awards

In an effort to recognize titles, national standings or accomplishments of members of the Carolina PBGV's, the Awards Committee will be recognizing PBGVs in the following areas. These awards must be earned during the time that the owner has been a member in good standing of the Carolina PBGV Club.

AKC & UKC Titles

Carolina PBGV Club will recognize any PBGV that has earned an AKC or UKC title during the calendar year. (January 1 to December 31)

PBGVs that are owned by members of the Carolina PBGV Club can download the award application for a plaque that will be awarded at the Awards Presentation at our annual meeting each year. A member must complete the application in order to be eligible for an award. These titles would include but are not limited to: conformation championships, obedience, rally, agility, hunting, tracking, therapy, lure coursing, and barn hunt. **Only AKC and UKC titles are eligible for Carolina PBGV Club awards.**

CGC must be a **title** not an award. *Previous to 2013 all CGCs were issued as an award from AKC, not a title. Beginning in January 2013, AKC gave owners the option to turn CGC awards (retroactive to January 2001) into a CGC title. Owners had to **apply and pay** for the CGC to become a title. For 2014 only, Carolina PBGV Club will grandfather in CGC titles from 2001 through 2013 where the owners have applied for an AKC CGC title and received the title certificate. Starting in 2014, CGC titles must be earned in 2014 to receive your award in 2015.*

REQUIREMENTS FOR RECOGNITION:

- Limited to members in good standing of the Carolina PBGV Club.
 - Co-ownerships permitted as long as one owner qualifies as member in good standing of Carolina PBGV Club. **One award per recognition.** Co-owners will not be awarded duplicate awards **unless co-owner is also a Carolina PBGV Club member and pays actual costs of award including any shipping.**
 - Points will only be tabulated for that period of time during which the dog is owned by a Carolina PBGV Club member in good standing.
 - Points are based on wins at AKC and UKC licensed shows, events, or trials only.
 - Points will be tabulated from January 1 to December 31 of each year for annual awards that would be presented the following year.
 - Awards of Recognition will be presented at the Carolina PBGV Club Annual Meeting.

- Carolina PBGV Club will not be responsible for shipping awards that are not awarded at the annual meeting **UNLESS** the member has sent a check for \$8 to the current Carolina PBGV Club Treasurer, Shirley Van Camp, _____

Titles and Venues (*minimum requirements*)

- Agility – AKC Novice Agility title (NA or NAP)
- Breed – AKC Champion (CH)
- Hunting – AKC Parent Club Junior Hunter (PCJH)

- Obedience – AKC Companion Dog Title (CD)
- Rally – Rally Advanced (RA)
- Tracking – AKC Tracking Dog (TD)

Awards must be in different disciplines. An upper level title (CDX, UD, OA, TDX, etc. does not count as two titles for a Versatility Award and only one agility title or one rally obedience title will be considered toward the Versatility Award. A Breed Championship is considered one venue.

Example - A dog/bitch earning a championship, obedience title, and agility title would be eligible for a versatility award. A dog/bitch earning an obedience title, a tracking title, and an agility title would be eligible for a versatility award.



Application for Carolina PBGV Club Award Recognition

Awards will be available for **AKC and UKC** titles earned between **January 1 through December 31, 2013** for PBGVs that have been, and are now owned, by Carolina PBGV Club Members in good standing. The dog must earn the title while the owner is a member.

Please complete an application for each dog and **each award requested**. Awards must be requested. You **MUST** include a copy of the AKC or UKC Certificate for the Award you are requesting with the application. Applications **must be mailed** to the Awards Chair. **No e-mailed applications will be accepted.**

In the case of ROM awards you must send the registration information on the get of the PBGV applying for the award. Copies of AKC certificates verifying eligibility for award must be included. AKC does offer a progeny report that would be valid for these awards. In the case of Versatility Awards owner must send a copy of title from each qualifying discipline.

Deadline for requesting plaques is **September 15, 2014**. No applications will be accepted after this date. **Plaques will not be mailed at club expense**. They can be picked up at the Carolina PBGV Club Annual Meeting or you can pay to have them mailed to you. Please note it is for your Award Plaque to be mailed to you.
