#### National 2017

Email from Beverly:

National 2017: Pam Helmer called me this morning to see if I would Co-Chair the 2017 National with the permanent Chair (who is Pam at this time.) The National Chair could change in the future because of Pam's health. I told her the Carolina PBGV Board had discussed and voted to try to bring the 2017 National to the Asheville area and the CClub was supportive. It looks like we can get this National and I committed since we have already voted to support this. If there is someone the Carolina Club would rather have Co-Chair it that is fine with me. My feelings won't be hurt. So let me know what you want to do.

Tony has checked out a few places in Asheville. The Asheville Crown Plaza (<a href="www.ashevillecp.com">www.ashevillecp.com</a>) he has looked at and said it was a great place to have a show. Pam said the room rates in PA were \$139 and they got them to \$100 for the show. The Crown Plaza is at \$139 also – we would have to get them down to at least \$100 to have there. Barbara Pepper is Chairing a dog show and it will be held at the Crown Plaza so I will check with her on how much their room rate is.

If we have a hunt with this show – it will be a national and the monies will go to the national. If we do the national in Asheville in early march, we will do the hunt in Seneca, SC

Things to think about -

- Do we want to have a hunt?
   all came out in favor of a hunt
   if we are going to do this we need to do it early in March cannot depend on the
   weather for hunts in Seneca in April/May .... May look toward the end of March
- Do we want to have a Carolina regional confirmation if we do this we would need a
  Carolina pbgv trophy committee
   Bobbe brought up the question of man power for a regional if we are doing the
  national and a hunt, the regional may be too much to handle

- -this is something we can think about, we have time to decide
- -some other club may want to do a regional (Mid NJ, Texas, etc)
- Shirley noted that at the mountain lodge some venues would be outdoors using big tents
  - Bobbe noted that there may be snow in March so that outside is less suitable Mike stated that the obedience/rally outside would not be possible
- Think about who could fill in different committee positions
  - do not want to put people out of showing obedience/agility/rally by using them to be chair committees
  - agility: who would be possible to chair agility? Megan, Paul, Phyllis, etc.
  - hunt: possible chairs? Mary, Paul (if not chairing agility)

#### Awards - Carolina PBGV

#### Email from Beverly:

Carolina PBGV Club Awards: I know a few of us are looking at some different things for our awards for the Carolina Club. We need to get a chair person for this and decide on:

- 1) How many years are we going back I think the club was formed in late 2005. Do we do 2005 2014? That could be a lot of awards but might not be. The owner would have to be a member in 2005 and still a member in 2014 and have to be a paid member the year the title was received. They would have to send proof (copy of AKC certificate, or UKC Certificate, etc.)
- 2) We need to decide if we are only recognizing AKC since we are an ACK Club or are we going to recognize UKC also. I would recommend we do AKC and UKC because some of our member do UKC events.
- 3) Once we decide if we are going to go back to 2005, then that will help decide what we are going to do award wise.
- 1. Awards will be by request
- 2. Use the two major registries AKC and UKC and hunting titles from PBGVCA
- 3. Deadline for requesting award and providing proof
- 4. In going back to the year the club was formed:
  - a. must have been a member of the club at the time received title and be a current member of the club
  - b. will get award for the highest title earned in that venue

Shirley has agreed to chair the committee for the awards for the Carolina PBGV Club Possibly paperweights then have them laser engraved – using club logo Shirley will look into the costs of the awards

This will be the only year we do retroactive awards

#### **Annual Awards**

In an effort to recognize titles, national standings or accomplishments of members of the Carolina PBGV's, the Awards Committee will be recognizing PBGVs in the following areas. These awards must be earned during the time that the owner has been a member in good standing of the Carolina PBGV Club.

#### **AKC & UKC Titles**

Carolina PBGV Club will recognize any PBGV that has earned an AKC or UKC title during the calendar year. (January 1 to December 31)

PBGVs that are owned by members of the Carolina PBGV Club can download the award application for a plaque that will be awarded at the Awards Presentation at our annual meeting each year. A member must complete the application in order to be eligible for an award. These titles would include but are not limited to: conformation championships, obedience, rally, agility, hunting, tracking, therapy, lure coursing, and barn hunt. Only AKC and UKC titles are eligible for Carolina PBGV Club awards.

CGC must be a **title** not an award. Previous to 2013 all CGCs were issued as an award from AKC, not a title. Beginning in January 2013, AKC gave owners the option to turn CGC awards (retroactive to January 2001) into a CGC title. Owners had to **apply and pay** for the CGC to become a title. For 2014 only, Carolina PBGV Club will grandfather in CGC titles from 2001 through 2013 where the owners have applied for an AKC CGC title and received the title certificate. Starting in 2014, CGC titles must be earned in 2014 to receive your award in 2015.

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR RECOGNITION:

- Limited to members in good standing of the Carolina PBGV Club.
- Co-ownerships permitted as long as one owner qualifies as member in good standing of Carolina PBGV Club. One award per recognition. Co-owners will not be awarded duplicate awards unless co-owner is also a Carolina PBGV Club member and pays actual costs of award including any shipping.
- Points will only be tabulated for that period of time during which the dog is owned by a Carolina PBGV Club member in good standing.
- Points are based on wins at AKC and UKC licensed shows, events, or trials only.
- Points will be tabulated from January 1 to December 31 of each year for annual awards that would be presented the following year.
- Awards of Recognition will be presented at the Carolina PBGV Club Annual Meeting.

 Carolina PBGV Club will not be responsible for shipping awards that are not awarded at the annual meeting **UNLESS** the member has sent a check for \$8 to the current Carolina PBGV Club Treasurer, Shirley Van Camp,

#### **Titles and Venues** (*minimum requirements*)

- Agility AKC Novice Agility title (NA or NAP)
- Breed AKC Champion (CH)
- Hunting AKC Parent Club Junior Hunter (PCJH)
- Obedience AKC Companion Dog Title (CD)
- Rally Rally Advanced (RA)
- Tracking AKC Tracking Dog (TD)

Awards must be in different disciplines. An upper level title (CDX, UD, OA, TDX, etc. does not count as two titles for a Versatility Award and only one agility title or one rally obedience title will be considered toward the Versatility Award. A Breed Championship is considered one venue.

Example - A dog/bitch earning a championship, obedience title, and agility title would be eligible for a versatility award. A dog/bitch earning an obedience title, a tracking title, and an agility title would be eligible for a versatility award.



## **Application for Carolina PBGV Club Award Recognition**

Awards will be available for **AKC and UKC** titles earned between **January 1 through December 31**, **2013** for PBGVs that have been, and are now owned, by Carolina PBGV Club Members in good standing. The dog must earn the title while the owner is a member.

Please complete an application for each dog and **each award requested**. Awards must be requested. You **MUST** include a copy of the AKC or UKC Certificate for the Award you are requesting with the application. Applications **must be mailed** to the Awards Chair. **No e-mailed applications will be accepted.** 

In the case of ROM awards you must send the registration information on the get of the PBGV applying for the award. Copies of AKC certificates verifying eligibility for award must be included. AKC does offer a progeny report that would be valid for these awards. In the case of Versatility Awards owner must send a copy of title from each qualifying discipline.

Deadline for requesting plaques is **September 15, 2014**. No applications will be accepted after this date. **Plaques will not be mailed at club expense.** They can be picked up at the Carolina PBGV Club Annual Meeting or you can pay to have them mailed to you. Mail a check made out to Carolina PBGV Club for \$8 to the current Carolina PBGV Club Treasurer, Shirley Van Camp 12217 Lawyers Rd. Mint Hill NC 28227. Please note it is for your Award Plaque to be mailed to you.
