CPBGVC Hunt Test Report—January 21-23, 2022 Tokeena Beagle Club, B pen (Old Grove Rd.)

## Chairperson's report

The hunt was held despite the threat of possible wintry mix and cold temperatures. As it happened, the weather was not as bad as predicted so everything worked out fine. The initial entry was larger than could be run within the stated time allowed each day so 3 runs were done on Friday (2 Saturday runs, 1 Sunday run). Three households dropped out at the last minute which cut the number of runs by at least 1 each day.

## Friday 1/21/22
